

Toileting Accident Clean-up Procedures



Assist child to the bathroom, using positive, supportive and “matter of fact” language. (Respond to other children’s questions the same way)

Put on gloves.

If changing mat is needed...

Place on open floor space in bathroom.

Remove wet or soiled clothing and place in empty plastic bag, tie to seal the bag.

If child is wearing a “pull up”...

Place “pull up” in a separate plastic bag, tie to seal the bag and place in a covered trash can.

If cleaning wipes are used...

Place wipes in a separate plastic bag (or with discarded “pull up”), tie to seal the bag and place in a covered trash can.

Assist child in re-dressing

Instruct child to wash their hands and return to classroom activities.

Wash, with soap & water, Rinse, with water, and Sanitize, with sanitizer to clean changing mat. If possible leave changing mat out to air dry-return to storage area when dry

Place the sealed plastic bag with wet or soiled clothing in the child’s cubby

Clean, with Wash, Rinse, and Sanitize, or discard any materials in the classroom that may be contaminated. Discarded items must be tie sealed in a plastic bag, and placed in a covered trash can. If items are too large for inside trash containers, they need to be removed to the outside trash receptacle

Remove gloves and wash hands
