Form Name: Behavior Intervention Strategies

Why It's Used: To ensure that teaching staff and parents have ruled out all external causes of a behavioral issue

How To Use: Review the list and make changes to the child's environment. Then, test the changes. Behavior issues may be relieved by using the intervention strategies

Deadlines: Teachers use immediately once they have identified a child who is struggling with the classroom structure or rules. Make changes in their classrooms. If external changes are not relieving the behaviors, discuss intervention strategies with parents during the "specifically" scheduled parent conference. Inform parents of the classroom changes and discuss the changes that can be made to the home environment that can help.
